Luke 19:12-13 and 15-24 – So He said, “A nobleman went to a distant country to receive a kingdom for himself, and then return. (13) And he called ten of his slaves, and gave them ten minas [to each one, one mina] and said to them, ‘Do business with this until I come back.’ (15) When he returned, after receiving the kingdom, he ordered that these slaves, to whom he had given the money, be called to him so that he might know what business they had done. (16) The first appeared, saying, ‘Master, your mina has made ten minas more.’ (17) And he said to him, ‘Well done, good slave, because you have been faithful in a very little thing, you are to be in *authority over ten cities.*’ (18) The second came, saying, ‘Your mina, master, has made five minas.’ (19) And he said to him also, ‘And you are to be *over five cities.*’ (20) Another came, saying, ‘Master, here is your mina, which I kept put away in a handkerchief; (21) for I was afraid of you, because you are an exacting man; you take up what you did not lay down and reap what you did not sow.’ (22) He said to him, ‘By your own words I will *judge* you, you worthless slave. Did you know that I am an exacting man, taking up what I did not lay down and reaping what I did not sow? (23) Then why did you not put my money in the bank, and having come, I would have collected it with interest?’ (24) Then he said to the bystanders, ‘Take the mina away from him and give it to the one who has the ten minas.’ “
